AUGUST NEWSLETTER 2021

Hi, friends. I have been looking forward to August in the pulpit as we shift gears in Ephesians and hear from Paul how, "to lead a life worthy of the calling," as he would say. Though we continue to explore scriptural unity, my news feed suggests that our state is trending toward another contentious season of debate regarding masking and social distancing. I thank you for your patient kindness. This is uncharted territory for me, but it feels like I've been living off of the map for some time. Can you relate?

Back in Springtime 2016, our family was nearing the half-way point of my studies at Asbury. Surviving Greek was pretty much my only goal in life, yet most conversations taking place in the study rooms, dining hall, and courtyards seemed to eventually drift toward the upcoming General Conference of the United Methodist Church. Though there was hope of a way forward, it was apparent that our denomination had arrived to an impasse and I sometimes wondered whether it would still be in one piece at graduation. Yet, our family stayed the course, simply believing that our God who brought us to this place would see us to the next.

About that time, I was presented the opportunity to be hired on as staff with my church as part of a mentoring program. The catch was that my participation would require me to be a part-time student. Seeing this as an opportunity to learn the ropes and remain in a safe harbor while the UMC storm blew over, I told my pastor that I wanted in. This is how I singlehandedly managed to squeeze three years of study into six and dash the hopes of my parents who wanted their grandchildren back home as soon as possible. Even so, I thought it was a good plan.

Just as the plan was to come to fruition, however, a global pandemic would have its own way. Pastors had just gone 9 rounds with the UMC crisis, only to end with a No Decision and a follow-up match with this new, unknown opponent. As a result, many who were pastors at the outset of Covid are no longer, including my own pastor who had brought me into the program those years ago. Ministry was tough and we likely made some missteps along the way, but we were figuring out how to build the plane mid-flight. Simple tasks had become difficult; policies and guidelines changed week-to-week. And that which was to last only a few weeks turned into an entire year.

Though my plan was for the storm to have long passed, our denominational issues (plus a pandemic) remain unresolved. As Coronavirus and its connected controversies threaten to flare up once again, I am cautious of its divisiveness and everaware of my inexperience in this new role. Yet, I know God has been at work in this church for a long, long time and is forever faithful. So, I have seen my part over these first weeks as following these simple rules: 1. Do no harm, 2. Do good, 3. Stay in love with God. These are known as Wesley's "Three General Rules," and though they are certainly open to a wide degree of interpretation, I want you to know they are near my heart as we figure this next part out together. Though I am sometimes tempted to yearn even for the simpler days of Greek exams, I count myself honored to be with you during this time. I truly would not have it any other way.
