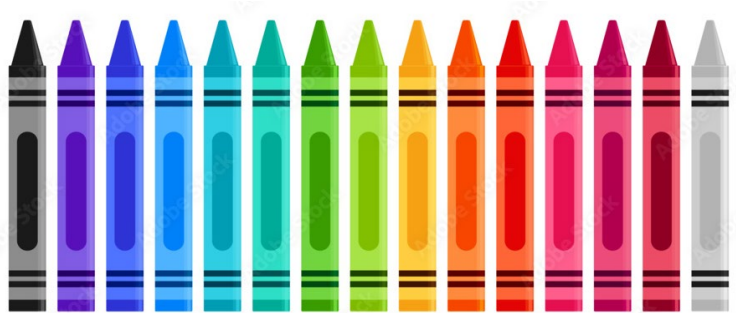
NOTE TO PARENTS
