We have purchased insurance, transferred the utilities, and arranged for pest service and lawn care. The house has been inspected for needed repairs and has undergone a real estate market evaluation.


We are currently forming teams to handle minor repairs and to dispose of items left in the house. A house cat and three feral cats remain at the house. Any advice on catching cats would help.
